Course

- Players are requested to walk quickly between shots and call faster players through. Remember your position in the field is immediately behind the players in front, not merely in front of the players behind. The maximum time for nine holes should be two hours ten minutes.
- Please repair all divots in fairway and rough. Please repair pitch marks on greens and rake bunkers after play, leaving the rake in the middle of the bunker facing the direction of play.
- Use the golf carts with care. They are to be driven at a responsible speed and in accordance with the rules printed on the windscreen of each golf cart.
- Lost ball – if you hit a ball into an area where the ball may be difficult to find, or out of bounds, always play a provisional ball from the same spot before you leave that position to go to find the first ball. The second ball must be declared a Provisional ball if you plan to play the first ball should it be found.
- The Club has adopted safe working practices. In all situations golfers must be called up or receive acknowledgement from course staff, who are in range, before playing a shot.

Clubhouse

- Smoking is not permitted in the Clubhouse.
- Individual Members and guests shall not directly reprimand any employee of the Club. Complaints must be communicated to the General Manager.

Mobile Phones

- Prohibited in Members' Lounge and Dining Room.
- Use on the golf course is strongly discouraged.

ROYAL QUEENSLAND GOLF CLUB DRESS CODE

1. Responsibility

Standard of dress and general appearance will, at all times, determine the privileges of all Members and their guests to use the facilities of the Clubhouse and Course, and shall be consistent with the dignity of the Club. It is the responsibility of the Members to ensure that they and their visitors comply with these regulations.

2. Men's Dress Requirements

- Trousers and shorts must be tailored.
- The following are not permitted: jeans, jean-style pants, pants with studs, cargo pants, cord or elastic top pants.
- Tailored shorts should be approximately knee length, but not below knee. The following are not permitted: three-quarter length shorts, cargo shorts, army style shorts with large side pockets, and cord or elastic top shorts.
- Shirts must have collars, sleeves, be clean and tucked in at all times. Skivvies with rolled collars are acceptable.
- If long socks are worn they must be kept up at all times.
- Acceptable short socks will be plain white (visitors only) or plain white with a Golf Club logo and at least 8cm above the ankle.
- Shirts, trousers, pullovers, jackets and hats must not display any advertising that is not directly related to sponsorship of golf – clothing manufacturers' logo excepted.
- Recognised Tennis attire must be worn. Shirts must have collars.

On the Course and Practice Areas:

- Golf shoes with soft spikes are preferred. Metal spikes are prohibited.

Dining Room:

- Jacket for evening dining is preferred, but smart casual wear is acceptable. (Special function notices will prescribe appropriate attire).

Members' Bar:

- Socks must be worn with shoes. Clean golf shoes with soft spikes are acceptable along with correct golf attire.

3. Associates' Dress Requirements

In the Clubhouse:

- Smart casual attire is acceptable.
- Denim jeans or skorts and clothing with prominent slogans and advertising are not acceptable.

On the Course and Practice Facilities:

- Skirts, shorts and neat shorts of appropriate length and slacks of any length are acceptable.
- Shirts worn outside must be designed for that purpose and at hip length.
- Denim attire and clothing with prominent slogans or advertising are not acceptable.
